- Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) Applications – Provide assistance to the advisors by encourage students to fill out these applications for their work in the agricultural industry and community. Also serve as general support to the activity.
- **FFA Camps, Conferences and Conventions – Provide assistance to the chapter in all capacities to ensure student experiences at these events.**
- Financial
  - WLC Scholarship – setup a scholarship for students wanting to attend WLC in the summer of their sophomore or junior years. The amount of the scholarship would be determined by alumni. Application process would be necessary on the behalf of the students interested in obtaining this scholarship.
  - **Camps and Conferences Scholarship – a partner scholarship that would present Alumni the ability to award a student a scholarship. Partners include community engagement sponsors or agricultural partners. 50% of funding would come from Shenandoah FFA Alumni.**

    - SAE Grants and Scholarships – encourage members to apply for SAE grant through National FFA. In addition to assisting senior FFA member file their scholarship applications through AgCN.
